Take a look at this [sample Transparency Portal](#) and let me know if you'd like anything changed. All fields can be edited, deleted or added to. Any of the fields in grey indicate information that will be pulled directly from your Flock account. The only other thing worth noting is the Search Audit...I have attached an example. There is nothing the public can gain from this report, as it only provides the search date, camera and search reason. However, if you find your department's users are not consistently searching off of incident/case numbers, that may be a reason to hide the Search Audit. It is entirely up to you but just like to point this out.

Once you approve this, I will publish the Transparency Portal and provide you with a link that can be added directly to your department's website. The only other thing I will need from you is a link to your LPR policy. It is important to note, you will want the link for just the LPR policy, not your full policy.

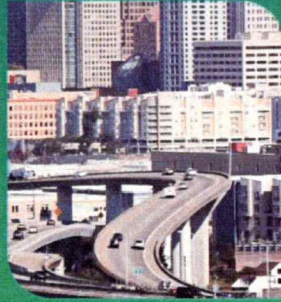
